The NHS guidance for infections is as followed:
 'It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, nursery or playgroup when they're unwell. **It's fine to send your child to school with a minor cough or common cold.** But if they have a fever, keep them off school until the fever goes.
 Encourage your child to throw away any used tissues and to wash their hands regularly.

If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school or nursery on the first day. Let them know that your child won't be in and give them the reason.'
