<u>IIIness</u>

When children contract an infectious or contagious disease, it is sometimes necessary that they do not attend school for a period of time. Please note that parents and carers should always contact school immediately if a child has any infectious disease in order that the necessary precautions can be made to safeguard the health of others.

Infectious Disease:	Recovery time needed at home:
Chicken Pox	5 days from onset of rash
German Measles and measels	5 days from onset of rash
Mumps	5 days from onset of swollen glands
Whooping cough	5 days after starting antibiotics
Tonsillitis	Until a clinical recovery is made

Contagious Disease:	Recovery time needed at home:
Vomiting/diarrhea	48 hours after it has stopped
Conjunctivitis	Until treated and infection cleared
Impetigo	Until lesion have healed or 48 hours
Verrucae/threadworm/ ringworm /athletes foot	Exclusion unnecessary (but treatment advisable)
Scabies	Until the day after treatment has started


