




Learning about Fire and Road Safety

We explored the key features of a nonchronological report, using owls as our focus.


The children looked closely at titles, subheadings and introductions, discussing why each one is important and how they help the reader understand information clearly.

We spotted these features in real reports and talked about how writers organise facts so they are easy to follow. The class showed great enthusiasm and worked brilliantly together.

We're now excited to use what we've learned to begin planning and writing our very own non-chronological reports soon!
