The first ten students kicked things off by participating in an Hour of Code, designing their own dance party complete with colourful characters, animated


backgrounds, and upbeat music. Creativity and coding combined!

They took part in a fascinating workshop about the Benty Grange Anglo-Saxon helmet and explored the museum's exhibits, bringing the past to life in exciting ways.









A Brilliant Tr




Y6 have been working so hard with their SATs preparation.
